Turk Blood Diluting Fluid, for Leukocyte Count

For In Vitro Diagnostic Use. Suitable for use as a diluting fluid for Leukocyte (white blood cell) counting. Typical Procedure: Draw well-mixed anticoagulated blood (EDTA recommended) or blood from a free-flowing capillary puncture to the 0.5 mark in a white-cell diluting pipet. Wipe off the outside of the pipet, then add Turk's Diluting Fluid to the 11 mark (1:20 dilution). Shake the pipet well for 3 minutes. Expel the first few drops from the pipet, then fill both sides of the hemocytometer. (Or prepare two pipets and use each to fill one side of the hemocytometer.) Count cells according to instructions supplied with the hemocytometer. Because this method also counts nucleated red blood cells, it may be necessary to apply a correction to the white-cell count. To determine the correction factor, count the number of nucleated red blood cells (NRBC) per 100 white blood cells; divide the total count by (100 + the number of NRBC) and multiply by 100 to obtain the white-cell count.
